Helen's career has spanned the global gem and jewellery industry, from roles with leading auction and jewellery houses to academic posts. For ten years she was a jewellery specialist for Sotheby's and Christie's in London and Geneva, where she handled sales of global importance including the private jewellery collection of HRH The Princess Margaret in 2006.

She has since held roles as Professeur d'Histoire du Bijoux at the Geneva University of Art and Design and as Managing Director of Gübelin Academy, which she created, built up and managed in Switzerland, Hong Kong and China.

Helen is currently Head of Business Development at Gembridge, a digital marketplace for coloured gemstones, and is also Editor-in-Chief of InColor, the quarterly magazine of the International Colored Gemstone Association.

A respected expert in the gem and jewellery industry, Helen has published and lectured widely on gems from ancient to modern. She is a Fellow of the Gemmological Associations of Great Britain and Hong Kong, and a Fellow of the Society of Antiquaries in London, and has a degree in Classics from Oxford.
