Alice Minter joined the V&A as Curator of the Rosalinde and Arthur Gilbert Collection in July 2018. Prior to that, she worked for 10 years at Sotheby's London as specialist in ceramics, silver and gold boxes. Alice has co-curated a ground-breaking display: *Concealed Histories: Uncovering the story of Nazi Looting Art* (6 December – 10 January 2021) and curated the touring exhibition *Masterpieces in miniatures: treasures from the Rosalinde & Arthur Gilbert Collection* which opened at the Diva museum in Antwerp in March 2021 and is currently touring in China. She is completing the catalogue and co-curating the forthcoming exhibition *Eternal Medium : Seeing the world in stones*, in collaboration with Los Angeles County Museum of Art (20 August 2023-February 2024)
